ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2960, S-2020

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE MONTHLY CITY ALLOWANCE OF THE ELECTION OFFICERS AND ELECTION ASSISTANTS AT THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS (COMELEC) - QUEZON CITY FIELD OFFICE AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-1001, S-2001.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a)(1)(xi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended, provides that "When the finances of the city government allow, provide for additional allowances and other benefits of judges, prosecutors, public elementary and high school teachers, and other national government officials stationed in or assigned to the city";

WHEREAS, Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. SP-1001, S-2001 provide, that:

"SECTION 1. Each of the Election Registrars assigned in the four congressional districts of Quezon City shall receive a monthly allowance of Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) per month."

"SECTION 2. The rank and file assigned under each of the four districts shall receive an allowance ranging from Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00) to One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00) monthly in accordance with their respective positions."

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor, through Executive Order No. 41, Series of 2019, reinstated the grant of monthly allowances to Election Officers and Election Assistants assigned at the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) - Quezon City Field Office in the amount of Three Thousand Pesos (Php3,000.00) and Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) respectively;

WHEREAS, the present monthly allowances provided by the city government to the Election Officers and Election Assistants pursuant to the said Executive Order No. 41, Series of 2019 are not at par with the allowance provided by other cities of the National Capital Region;

WHEREAS, in order to cope up with the present economic situation and inflation rate, there is a need to increase the city allowance for Election Officers from Three Thousand Pesos (Php3,000.00) to Ten Thousand Pesos (Php10,000.00), and Election Assistants from Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) to Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The monthly allowances provided by the Quezon City Government to the Election Officers are hereby increased subject to the conditions set forth under Section 2 of Executive Order No. 41, Series of 2019

The increase shall be as follows:

Total: Php330,000.00/mo x 12 mos = Php3,960,000.00

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION – The City Government shall appropriate the amount of Three Million Nine Hundred Sixty Thousand Pesos (Php3,960,000.00), or as necessary, in the City's Annual Budget, from any available funds of the City Treasury, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations of the Commission on Audit.



All other ordinances, executive orders, local issuances of rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
