EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4

CONSTITUTING THE QUEZON CITY LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (QCLYDC)

WHEREAS, Section 13 of the 1987 of the Constitution recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being;

WHEREAS. Section 23 of Republic Act 10742 otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act provides that there shall be in every province, city and municipality a Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) mandated to assist the planning and execution of projects and programs of the Sangguniang Kabataan, and the Pederasyons in all levels;

WHEREAS, the youth council shall serve as the main advocate for youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment, monitoring and implementation of programs and projects under the Local Youth Development Plan.

WHEREAS, Section 24(i) Rule III of the Rules and Regulations Implementing Republic Act 10742 states that the LYDC shall be composed of at least ten (10) but not more than twenty one (21) members including the two (2) core members shall be composed of the president and the vice-president of the concerned Pederasyon and shall be supported by at least eight (8) but not more than nineteen (19) other representatives from registered youth organizations or youth serving organizations;

WHEREAS, the convening and election of members of Quezon City Local Youth Development Council was conducted on July 9, 2018 spearheaded by the Local Youth Development Office (LYDO), supervised by the Department of the Interior and Local Government Quezon City Field Office, Secretary to the Sangguniang Panglungsod and Barangay and Community Relations Department;

NOW, THEREFORE I, MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, Mayor of Quezon City, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. CREATION. The Quezon City Local Youth Development Council (QCLYDC) is hereby reconstituted.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The QCLYDC shall be composed of the following:

2.1 Chairperson : The Quezon City SK Pederasyon President

2.2 Vice Chairperson: The Quezon City SK Pederasyon Vice President

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The QCLYDC shall have the following duties and functions:

- 3.1 Serve as the core of the advocacy on youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment;
- 3.2 Finalize the three (3) year Local Youth Development Plan (LYDP) that is anchored in the Philippine Youth Development Plan (PYDP) and the development plans of City. This shall be submitted to the City Mayor for inclusion in the Local Development Plan and subsequently endorsed to the Sanggunian Panlungsod for approval. These plans shall give priority to programs, projects and activities that will promote and ensure the meaningful youth participation in nation-building, sustainable youth development and empowerment, equitable access to quality education, environmental protection, climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction and resiliency, youth employment and livelihood, health and anti-drug abuse, gender sensitivity, social protection, capability building and sports development;
- 3.3 Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Youth Development Plan:
- 3.4 Coordinate with the National Youth Commission (NYC) and other agencies to achieve effectively the objectives and attain the goals of the LYDP;
- 3.5 Perform other functions as may be prescribed by law or ordinance relative to Quezon City youth programs or as the City Mayor, DILG, NYC may require.

SECTION 4. CONVENING OF THE LYDC. The LYDC shall schedule a meeting every quarter, and as often as needed.

SECTION 5. SECRETARIAT. The Local Youth Development Officer (LYDO) shall provide secretariat services to the Quezon City Local Youth Development Council. Accordingly, the LYDO shall assist in the conduct of meetings, take charge of communications and notices, prepare reports, and take custody of all records, data, information and documents of the QCLYDC.

SECTION 6. RESOURCE AVAILABILITY. Until such time that the Quezon City Local Youth Development Office (QCLYDO) is given budget for the purpose stated herein, the funding necessary to carry out the functions of the QCLYDC shall be sourced from the Office of the City Mayor or from any available funds of the City in accordance with the government accounting and auditing management and procedures, other existing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 7. CONSISTENCY WITH LOCAL PLANS. For planning purposes, the initiatives emanating from the QCLYDC shall be consistent with the Quezon City Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP), and Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP).

SECTION 8. DISSEMINATION. A copy of this Executive Order shall be furnished to the Office of the President and the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) for information and guidance, pursuant to Section 455(1) (xii) of RA 7160, as amended, and shall be posted at the official website of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
