



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 31-B
Series of 2020

**AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 31, SERIES 2020,
ENTITLED: "REGULATING THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION AND
CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR AND OTHER INTOXICATING BEVERAGES
WITHIN THE CITY DURING THE MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY
QUARANTINE PERIOD" THEREBY EXTENDING ITS APPLICABILITY
DURING THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ).**

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2020, upon recommendation of the IATF-MEID, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte placed the National Capital Region (NCR) under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) starting on June 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, the coverage of Executive Order No. 31, Series of 2020 is limited only during the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine, hence, there is a need to amend the same to cover the period of the General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, under Section 455(b)(1)(vii) of the *Local Government Code*, the Mayor may carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during times of calamity.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, *City Mayor* of Quezon City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do order:

SECTION 1. The regulation of the sale, distribution and consumption of liquor and other intoxicating beverages within the City during the Modified Enhanced Community quarantine period stated under Executive Order No. 31, Series of 2020, shall likewise apply during the General Community Quarantine (GCQ).

Except the expansion of its applicability even during the GCQ, the conditions and strict enforcement provisions of *EO 31, Series 2020* shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. Executive Order No. 31, Series of 2020 is hereby modified accordingly. All other circulars, issuances, orders, or directives inconsistent with this Order are hereby rescinded or repealed accordingly.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
