**REORGANIZING THE QUEZON CITY PEOPLES' LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD
(PLEB)**

WHEREAS, Republic Acts 6975 and 8551 mandates for the creation of the Peoples' Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) for every five hundred (500) city or municipal police personnel and for each of the legislative districts in a city.

WHEREAS, above-cited laws supplemented by the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2016-02 and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2017-157 provided for the creation of the said Board composed of the following:

- a. A member of the Sanggunian Panlungsod chosen by the respective Sanggunian
- b. A Punong Barangay of the city concerned chosen by the Liga ng mga Barangay
- c. Three (3) other members to be chosen by the city Peace and Order Council from among the respected members of the community known for their probity and integrity. One (1) of whom must be woman and another a member of the BAR in the absence thereof, a college graduate, or the Principal of the central elementary school in the locality

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Peace and Order Council conducted series of deliberation to ensure paramount selection of the members of the six (6) PLEBs in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, in the interest of public service and pursuant to existing laws and regulations governing the creation of the Peoples' Law Enforcement Board (PLEB), the Quezon City PLEB is hereby reconstituted as follows:

The duties, functions and responsibilities of the members of the PLEB shall be pursuant to the provisions of the Republic Acts 6975 and 8551 supplemented by the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2016-02 and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2017-157.

The members of the Quezon City Peoples' Law Enforcement Board are hereby authorized to claim honoraria amounting to Twelve Thousand Pesos (Php 12, 000.00) per month computed on the basis of their actual attendance to the Board Hearings. Also, those members who are holding their position in hold over capacity are hereby authorized to claim their respective honoraria amounting to Twelve Thousand Pesos (Php 12, 000.00) per month computed on the basis of their actual attendance to the Board Hearings conducted.

The City Administrator is likewise authorized to sign all papers and documents on matters affecting PLEB. He shall be authorized to receive a monthly honoraria amounting to Three Thousand Peso (PhP 3,000.00).


The following Legal Consultants as per *NAPOLCOM Special Order No. 2019-105* are hereby authorized to claim a monthly honoraria amounting to One Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,000.00) each, to wit:

Finally, effective immediately, ATTY. RAFAEL VICENTE R. CALINISAN is hereby designated as the PLEB Executive Officer, in concurrent capacity. He is directed to report and confer with the City Administrator on all matters pertaining to the operations of the PLEB and ensure that all requirements of the annual PLEB audit are in place, in coordination with the NAPOLCOM and the local DILG Office.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
