

WHEREAS, aside from Best Police District, QCPD bagged awards for eight units and individuals, the Best Unit for its Project Double Barrel (Police District Level), the Kamuning Police Station (PS-10) as the Best Unit for Project Double Barrel (Numbered Police Station level) and as Best Numbered Police Station for having the most number of firearms confiscated (Police District Level), Payatas PCP of Batasan Police Station (PS-6) as Best Police Community Precinct;

WHEREAS, the individual awards were presented to PLtCol. Teresita Escamillan as Best Junior Police Commissioned Officer for Administration, Cpl. Mark Anthony Rigor as the Best Junior Police Non-Commissioned Officer for Administration and Willy Meneses Santos for Best Non-Uniformed Personnel (Supervisory Level);


