RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8293**, S-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO PURCHASE THREE (3) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AMOUNTING TO FOUR MILLION SIXTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (PHP4,016,800.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROVED 2020 BUDGET OF THE BARANGAY AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS DEPARTMENT (BCRD), SAID VEHICLES WILL BE OFFICIALLY USED FOR MOBILITY, IN THE EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF 142 BARANGAYS.

WHEREAS, the Local Government of Quezon City is committed in providing valuable basic services to the residents of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD) specifically the Field Coordinators are in great need of vehicles to be able to effectively and efficiently perform their official functions;

WHEREAS, the said vehicles to be purchased will be used officially to provide assistance, monitoring and mobilization (programs) and to support the needs of the 142 barangays and community organizations;

WHEREAS, the motor vehicles to be procured are described as follows:

WHEREAS, the cost of one vehicle is One Million Four Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php1,472,800.00) and the other two vehicles will cost a total of Two Million Five Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Pesos (Php2,544,000.00);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 1 amending Administrative Order No. 233 Series of 2008, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, has already sought permission and authorization from the DILG in her letter addressed to DILG City Director Mr. Emmanuel D. Borromeo, CESO V, for acquisition of the above-described motor vehicles, which amount is included in the Approved 2020 Annual Budget of the Quezon City Government specifically the Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor, as the Chief Executive of the City Government, shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bond, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the registration, maintenance and other dues of the said vehicles will be shouldered by the said department through their appropriate funds;

WHEREAS, the Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD) deals with the 142 Barangays in Quezon City through its Barangay Officials;

WHEREAS, the Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD) acts as the administrative and operational arm of the Quezon City Government on Barangay matters;


WHEREAS, the Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD) is one of the major conduits in attaining the goals and in achieving the mission, vision and thrust of the City Mayor towards the growth and development of the barangays as well as strengthening its initiative and actions in the delivery of necessary services to the Quezon City constituents;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of attaining the city and national goals, the purchase of said vehicles will be of great help to be able to provide the mobilization for monitoring of different programs and projects of 142 Barangays as well as to provide assistance including those of Accredited Community Organizations.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to purchase three (3) units of motor vehicles amounting to Four Million Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php4,016,800.00) to be charged against the Approved 2020 Budget of the Barangay and Community Relations Department (BCRD), said vehicles will be officially used for mobility, in the effective and efficient monitoring of programs and projects of the 142 Barangays.


