#### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

#### SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, TESTING AND COMMISSIONING OF ONLINE LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

#### I. RATIONALE AND BRIEF BACKGROUND

Online learning is considered a new norm in today's education world. In fact, the use of technology in teaching is being used as an important indicator of the quality education in many institutions in the world. Also, in this era of new normal, education institutions are in great need of online materials for the continuity learning process. The Schools Division of Quezon City, in its desire to provide better education tools to its teachers and better learning experience to its students, deems it necessary to employ an online learning system with learning management and analytics features including supplementary learning materials. The learning system is a complete package of learning tools and resources to support and equip the schools, teachers, and students under the Division of Quezon City to maximize the benefit of the new K-12 curriculum and 21st century learning skills.

#### II. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- A. For Schools/Division office:
  - 1. Support the schools in providing access to pre-developed and teacher made materials aligned with the current curriculum.
  - 2. Provide the best tool to continue education and improve academic performance of the students
  - 3. Assist the Schools Division Office and school administrators to check and evaluate the teachers' performance and students' progress more efficiently through a secure online platform with easy monitoring functions.
- B. For Teachers:
  - 1. Minimize the workload of the teachers in preparing learning materials for the students
  - 2. Centralize access to video lessons, downloadable study guides (ebooks), assessment questions, downloadable lesson plans, downloadable presentations and worksheets and other learning resources anytime, anywhere.
  - 3. Automate class management tasks such as distribution and collection of homework, computation of grades, and recording of student activities.
  - 4. Generate the academic weakness and strength of the students through analytics.
- C. For Students
  - 1. Centralize access to ready-made video lessons, downloadable study guides and answer assessments anytime, anywhere.
  - 2. Help the students to improve their overall academic performance and cultivate better learning habits with an online learning platform which <del>p</del> enable self-paced learning.
- D. For Parents
  - 1. Access to a secure online platform where they can monitor the children's academic performance and progress anytime, anywhere.

    - a. announcements to multiple classes and/or messages to individual students
  - 10. Creating, uploading, and sharing of teacher-made content for
    - a. their students and other teachers from the same school/Division
  - 11. - iii. Training/Orientation of DepEd officers, school administrators,
  - teachers, students, and parents
    - Assigned DepEd officers and school administrators will shall be trained in how to utilize the analytics function to monitor the teachers' and the students' usage
    - The teachers will be trained in how to utilize the learning management system and the learning resources to maximize the learning outcomes of the students
    - 3. The students will be oriented on how to utilize the learning platform and maximize their academic potential
    - 4. The parents will be oriented in the benefit of the new eLearning system and how they can use the system to monitor their children's activities. (Optional)
- iv. Reporting
  - A dedicated local specialist shall make regular scheduled communication with the DepEd officers and schools to deliver the monthly report relevant in supporting the teachers and students to improve platform usage
  - 2. When needed, interim reports shall be made available upon request
- v. Consulting
  - A dedicated local specialist shall make regular scheduled communication with the Division Office and schools to consult for any eLearning related concerns
  - 2. Feedback from students and teachers shall be gathered and reflected on the product development process to continuously improve and better serve the users
  - 3. New programs and campaigns will be suggested and discussed to improve the eLearning status of the Division in general
- vi. Technical Support
  - 1. A dedicated local IT engineer team stationed within the National Capital Region, Philippines originally involved in coding the online

learning platform shall be assigned to continuously monitor, maintain, and update the platform and the service

- 2. A dedicated team of local technical specialists within the National Capital Region, Philippines, shall be made available to maintain the system's integrity and address any technical issues
- Students, parents, teachers and DepEd Officers should be able to call or text a dedicated hotline number or send message to designated Social Networking Service accounts to communicate with the local customer service team within the National Capital Region, Philippines during the working hours from 8:00AM-5:00PM (Monday-Friday)

## IV. AREA OF COVERAGE/ ACCESSIBILLITY

- a. Cloud-based learning management system
- b. No physical server installation required
- c. Accessible using ANY desktop PC, laptop, tablets, and other mobile devices with web browsing function using ANY browser such as Safari, Google Chrome, Internet Explorer and Mozilla Firefox.
- d. Video downloading function for offline viewing thru an android application that can be downloaded from Google Play store

## V. PROJECT STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS

SUPPLIER will provide:

- 1. Student and Teacher accounts (user ID and password)
- 2. On-site/Online training/orientation for the assigned DepEd officers, school administrators, teachers and students (optional for parents)
- 3. Assign a dedicated learning integration specialist (LIS)
  - a. The specialist will provide monthly reports to school heads about the utilization of the teachers and students
  - b. The specialist will also provide consulting services on how to maximize the benefit of the eLearning system by planning such activities/programs as inter/intra school competitions
- 4. After-sales service (technical support)
- 5. On-site and/or online response depending on the urgency/severity of the technical issue.
- 6. As part of the requirements in RA 9184, the Bidder must have completed a government or private contract that is SIMILAR in nature to this project within the last three (3) years equivalent to at least fifty (50%) of the approved budget for the contract (ABC).

END-USER is expected to:

- 1. Orient the LIS on the school profile, mission and vision, policies and guidelines
- Delegate at least one (1) School Program coordinator per beneficiary school that will work closely with the LIS to ensure the school's eLearning service will be carried out, monitored, and evaluated

### **VI. PROJECT DURATION**

The project duration will be for One (1) year period.

### VII. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT (ABC)

The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to Php 35,700,000.00.

## VIII. BASIS OF PAYMENT

- 1. Only Student accounts are billable.
- 2. Transferees and dropout students are nonrefundable and shall not affect the number of activated student accounts.
- 3. The price

a)The fixed cost (will not be affected by the duration of the usage)

- *i.* Initial setup, training and orientation for the administrators, teachers, and students (10% of the total price)
- *ii.* Content including the video lessons, downloadable study guide/e-books, and assessment questions (75% of the total price)
- b)The variable cost (will change based on the duration of the usage)
  - ii. Platform usage (15% of the total price)
- 4. After service has been rendered, payment shall be made. The payment is the total number of delivered student accounts multiplied by the unit price.
- 5. This is subject to full compliance to the Procurement Law (RA 9184) and auditing rules and regulations.

# XI. PENALTIES FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT

Failure to deliver the services according to the standards and requirements set by the City shall constitute an offence and shall subject the Contractor to penalties and/or liquidated damages pursuant to RA 9184 and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.

### **XII. CANCELLATION OR TERMINATION OF CONTRACT**

The guidelines contained in RA 9184 and its revised IRR shall be followed in the termination of any service contract. In the event the City terminated the Contract due to default insolvency, or for cause, it may enter into negotiated procurement pursuant to section 53 (d) of RA 9184 and its IRR.
