ORDINANCE NO. SP-3035, S-2021

AN ORDINANCE CONVERTING THE EXISTING HOLY SPIRIT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL-ANNEX LOCATED AT REPUBLIC AVENUE, BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT INTO A SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Section 392, Paragraph 21 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the barangay shall initiate the establishment of a barangay high school, whenever feasible, in accordance with law;

WHEREAS, there is an existing high school-annex in Barangay Holy Spirit located in Republic Avenue, Barangay Holy Spirit known as Holy Spirit National High School-Annex;

WHEREAS, the existing Holy Spirit National High School-Annex has the available space necessary for the construction and expansion of the school facilities;

WHEREAS, due to the increasing student population of Holy Spirit National High School-Annex, it is proper that a separate and independent high school be established in order to hasten the delivery of educational support and services by the Quezon City Government for the benefit of students;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay of Holy Spirit passed a Resolution No. 037-A, S-2020 endorsing Holy Spirit National High School-Annex as an independent city public high school;

WHEREAS, the Local School Board of Quezon City issued Resolution No. 12, S-2020 recommending to the Sangguniang Panlungsod the establishment of an educational institution at Simon Street, Barangay Holy Spirit.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established in Barangay Holy Spirit, Quezon City another separate and independent high school.

SECTION 2. The Holy Spirit National High School-Annex located at Republic Avenue, Barangay Holy Spirit, Quezon City is hereby separated from Holy Spirit National High School and converted into an independent high school.

SECTION 3. The separate and independent high school established under this Ordinance shall be for Grade 7 to Grade 12 students.

SECTION 4. All assets, real and personal, personnel, and records of the Holy Spirit National High School-Annex, are hereby transferred to the separate and independent high school upon the effectivity of this Ordinance. All plantilla positions shall be retained, with the rights and security of tenure of teachers and personnel therein employed under existing laws and regulations.

SECTION 5. The City Mayor is hereby authorized to utilize, realign and/or transfer available funds from the Special Education Fund or any available funds of the Quezon City Government for the proper implementation of this Ordinance. Subsequent appropriations necessary for the operation of the separate high school shall be included in the annual budget of the City.

SECTION 6. The City Mayor shall create a Special Committee for proper implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
