RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6956, S-2016

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY ENCOURAGING ALL BARANGAYS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENGINEERING AND PUBLIC WORKS TO CONTINUOUSLY BE COMMITTED IN THE DECLOGGING OF ALL DRAINAGES AND WATERWAYS IN THE PERENNIALY FLOOD PRONE AREAS THIS RAINY SEASON.

WHEREAS, the existing drainage facility of the City consists of concrete-lined canals, waterways, sidewalk gutters and reinforced pipes laid-out. Drainage lines are mainly covered particularly in areas where there is a large volume of traffic. However, momentary flooding is experienced during heavy rains due to some clogging along the lines. Declogging and desilting have to be done in order to prevent similar events from happening;

WHEREAS, during the rainy season especially during typhoons, the perennial problem of flood due to clogged waterways such as canals, drainages and esteros is a constant problem of the metropolis not just in terms of traffic but also of accidents and life threatening incidents caused by open manholes that are unknown to many motorists and pedestrians alike;

WHEREAS, many serious health risks or diseases among which are leptospirosis and dengue are attributed to dirty flood waters exposing many to the dangers of such deadly diseases;

WHEREAS, it is only logical that this City be prepared especially this coming rainy season.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby strongly encourage all Barangays and the Department of Engineering and Public Works to continuously be committed in the declogging of all drainages and waterways in the perennially flood prone areas this rainy season.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Department of Engineering and Public Works be encouraged to replace missing manholes and the damaged ones.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all the Barangays in Quezon City and the Department of Engineering and Public Works.


