A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE DEEDS OF DONATION AND ACCEPTANCE SIGNED BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH-METRO MANILA CENTER FOR HEALTH DEVELOPMENT (DOH-MMCHD) FOR THE DONATION OF EIGHT (8) UNITS OF AMBULANCE INCLUDING THE EQUIPMENT THEREIN TO BE USED BY THE QUEZON CITY SUPER HEALTH CENTERS.

WHEREAS, the Department of Health program known as "Boosting Universal Health Care via FOURmula One for Health Plus (or F1+)" envisions quality health care to be more accessible to the poor and vulnerable population by ensuring the availability of functional health care facilities; 63rd Regular Session

WHEREAS, the Health Facilities Enhancement Program (HFEP) aims to improve the delivery of health services through the upgrading of health facilities and provision of medical equipment in order to make them more responsive to the health needs of the population;

WHEREAS, the provision of ambulance shall contribute to the functionality of the health system and the delivery of quality health care;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is a partner of the Department of Health in implementing programs and delivering quality health services to the people of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health-Metro Manila Center for Health Development (DOH-MMCHD) has donated and the Quezon City Government has accepted eight (8) units of ambulance including the equipment therein amounting to Two Million One Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (Php2, 140,000.00) per unit to be used by the following Super Health Centers, to wit: (1) Bagong Silangan Super Health Center, (2) Betty Go Belmonte Super Health Center, (3) Payatas Super Health Center, (4) Murphy Super Health Center, (5) Arsenia J. Maximo Super Health Center, (6) Sta. Lucia Super Health Center, (7) NGC Super Health Center, and (8) Batasan Hills Super Health Center;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify, the Deeds of Donation and Acceptance signed by and between the Quezon City Government, represented by the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, and the Department of Health-Metro Manila Center for Health Development (DOH-MMCHD) for the donation of eight (8) units of ambulance including the equipment therein to be used by the Quezon City Super Health Centers. 63rd Regular Session
