WHEREAS, President Benigno Simeon C. Aquino III, born on February 8, 1960, served as the 15th President of the Philippines from 2010 to 2016;

WHEREAS, President Benigno Aquino III, also known as President Noynoy or PNoy, was the son of Democracy Icons, Senator Benigno S. Aquino, Jr. and President Corazon "Cory" C. Aquino;

WHEREAS, President Aquino attended elementary, high school and college at Ateneo de Manila University in Quezon City where he finished his Bachelor of Arts Major in Economics;

WHEREAS, President Aquino served as Representative of the 2nd District of Tarlac in the House of Representatives from 1998 to 2007 and as Senator of the Republic of the Philippines from 2007 to 2010;
