WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) through a Memorandum Circular, declares that a local authority may establish a relationship with its counterpart within the country or abroad to promote development initiatives that are mutually beneficial to the concerned government;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City to foster friendship, trade, understanding and cooperation;

WHEREAS, Naga City is known to be the Queen City of Bicol as well as the Heart of Bicol. It is also the center of the Region's

trade, business, religious, cultural, industrial and financial district and has improved accessibility through an airport that connects to the City from Manila via local carriers. The same is also accessible by the different mode of land transportation including the Philippine National Railways;


WHEREAS, through the establishment of sisterhood ties, Quezon City and Naga City, who are both growing and developing cities, will have an opportunity for an exchange of ideas, technology, skills, and expertise to expand its connection in bringing about progress and advancement in their respective localities;

WHEREAS, the establishment of sisterhood ties is mutually beneficial to Quezon City and Naga City especially in the attainment of their fullest development, improvement of public governance, and increase of self-reliance as a local government unit.


NOW, THEREFORE,


