RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6873**, S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO ENTER INTO A JOINT VENTURE AGREEMENT WITH A QUALIFIED PRIVATE SECTOR PROPONENT TO UNDERTAKE THE DESIGN, FINANCING, CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF AN INTEGRATED SOLID WASTE-TO-ENERGY FACILITY IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is mandated under Republic Act No. 7160 to discharge functions and responsibilities necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of basic services and facilities, including solid waste disposal systems and services or facilities related to general hygiene and sanitation;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council enacted on 11 August 2014 Ordinance No. SP 2336, S-2014, entitled "Quezon City Code Pursuing a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Approach Towards Development, Providing for the Procedure for Selecting the Private Sector Proponent, Adopting a Contract Management Framework, and Providing Appropriations and For Other Purposes," consistent with the LGU's

policy to advance the public good and general welfare, and promote the interest of the community and Quezon City within the framework of sustainable and integrated development, and effective constructive engagement and meaningful people's participation in local governance;


WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, issued Executive Order No. 16, S-2015, entitled: "Convening the Public Private Partnership (PPP) Selection Committee", which shall be the responsible body for all aspects of pre-selection and selection of private sector proponents for PPP projects;

WHEREAS, solid waste management project is one of the Development Projects that has been identified by the PPP Selection Committee that may be undertaken through PPP as defined and provided under the Ordinance;

WHEREAS, based on the Waste Analysis and Characterization Study (WACS) conducted in 2013, each person generates around .88 kilograms of waste per day with a total of Three Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Six (3176) tons per day for the year 2016 based on the projected population. Of this, around 1,700 tons are disposed per day in the Payatas Sanitary Landfill (PSL). Due to the increase in population and economic growth, Quezon City waste generation is expected to continuously increase;

WHEREAS, due to the increase in waste generation and the depleting space and life span of the PSL the City's disposal facility is nearing its maximum capacity in three (3) years. In the event that the PSL be closed without any in-city alternative sites, the city would be forced to haul its Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) to facilities outside its geographic boundaries, which could result to additional annual expenditure;

WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor Herbert M. Bautista shall ensure that the proposed project configuration of the PSP shall guarantee compliance with all required laws and regulations, including but not limited to: Republic Act No. 9003, The Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000; Republic Act No. 8749, Clean Air Act; Republic Act No. 9275, Clean Water Act; Republic Act No. 6969, Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes Act;




Republic Act No.9513, Renewable Energy Act of 2008; Presidential Decree No. 1586 Establishing an Environmental Impact Statement System; and Guidelines governing the establishment and operation of waste-to-energy technologies for municipal solid wastes.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a Joint Venture Agreement with a qualified Private Sector Proponent to undertake the design, financing, construction, operation, and maintenance of an integrated solid waste-to-energy facility in Quezon City.


