A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) ENTERED INTO AND SIGNED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, WITH THE PHILIPPINE RED CROSS (PRC), SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government (QCG), pursuant to its objective of providing a clean and green environment to its constituents, entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Red Cross;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Red Cross (PRC) has truly become the premier humanitarian organization in the country, committed to provide quality life-saving services that protect the life and dignity especially of indigent Filipinos in vulnerable situations;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Red Cross provides six major services: Blood Services, Disaster Management Services, Safety Services, Health Services, Social Services, Red Cross Youth and Volunteer Services. All of them embody the fundamental principles of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement - humanity, impartiality, neutrality, independence, voluntary service, unity and universality. These values guide and inspire all Red Cross staff and volunteers, to whom being a Red Crosser is more than just a philosophy but a way of life;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Red Cross (PRC) and the Quezon City Government (QCG) in response with DILG MC No. 2015-12 dated 13 February 2015 which will form part of the City Mayor's capability build up program, to insure and give assistance health benefits and priority to blood in case of emergency;

WHEREAS, through the said Memorandum of Agreement, the Philippine Red Cross (PRC) agreed to provide accidental/medical assistance benefits to its members and insurance coverage for One (1) year and build up Red Cross Youth Council in Girls Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) and the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) in each school/per district of Quezon City;


WHEREAS, in view thereof, there is a need to ratify the Memorandum of Agreement signed by the parties and to authorize Honorable Herbert M. Bautista in his capacity as the Mayor of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby authorizes Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, City Mayor, for and in behalf of the Quezon City Government, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Red Cross (PRC).


NOW, THEREFORE,


