RESOLUTION NO. SP. 6893, S-2016

ISSUANCE OFRESOLUTION **AUTHORIZING** THECERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO DMCI CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF "INFINA TOWERS", A FORTY (40)-STOREY RESIDENTIAL CONDOMINIUM WITH ROOFDECK (BLDG. A) AND CONDOMINIUM RESIDENTIAL FORTY (40)-STOREY MEZZANINE AND ROOFDECK ON A COMMON FIVE (5) BASEMENT PARKING TO BE LOCATED AT LOT 2, BLOCK 13-C, NO. 992 AURORA BOULEVARD, BARANGAY MARILAG, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE FLOOR AREA RATIO ONLY PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-918, S-2000, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED.

## Introduced by Councilor MARVIN C. RILLO.

WHEREAS, DMCI Corporation, represented by Mr. Elmer G. Civil, is applying for a Certificate of Exception for the construction of "Infina Towers", a forty (40)-storey residential condominium with roofdeck (Bldg. A) and forty (40)-storey residential condominium with mezzanine and roofdeck on a common five (5) basement parking to be located at Lot 2, Block 13-C, No. 992, Aurora Boulervard, Barangay Marilag, Quezon City, a classified Major Commercial (C-2) Zone as per Project Evaluation prepared by the City Planning and Development Office;

WHEREAS, based on the project evaluation made by the said office, the proposed project has a total floor area of 216,476.00 square meters which require 2,852 parking slots. Thus, the alloted 1,667 parking slots, as per plan, do not conform with the existing zoning ordinance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Articles IV, V, VI and VIII of Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, as amended, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, an Exception is required for the aforesaid project upon authorization from the City Council;

WHEREAS, the proposed project will not adversely affect public health, safety, and welfare and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;

WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with the necessary requirements prescribed by law, ordinance or administrative issuances.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the issuance of a Certificate of Exception to DMCI Corporation for the construction of "Infina Towers", a forty (40)-storey Residential Condominium with Roofdeck (Bldg. A) and forty (40)-storey Residential Condominium with Mezzanine and Roofdeck on a common five (5) Basement Parking to be located at Lot 2, Block 13-C, No. 992, Aurora Boulevard, Barangay Marilag, Quezon City, allowing deviation from the floor area ratio only provided under Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, otherwise known as the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance, as amended.
