RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6905**, S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE AN "AIR QUALITY MONITORING SYSTEM" EQUIPMENT, TO BE UTILIZED BY ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (EPWMD) - QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG), SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that, "the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, Section 455 (4) of the same Code provides "Ensure the delivery of basic services and the provision of adequate facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code and, in addition thereto, shall:

(i) Ensure that the construction and repair of roads and highways funded by the national government shall be, as far as practicable, carried out in a spatially contiguous manner and in coordination with the construction and repair of the roads and bridges of the city, x.x.x; and

(ii) Coordinate the implementation of technical services, including public works and infrastructure programs, rendered by national offices in the case of highly urbanized and independent component cities, and by national and provincial offices in the case of component cities.

WHEREAS, it is high time that the request of the Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department (EPWMD) of the Quezon City Government, to procure said equipment, necessary for the implementation, of their programs and/or projects;

WHEREAS, the air quality monitoring system equipment's purpose is to characterize local air pollution. The goal of this air quality monitoring is to protect humans and the environment from harmful air pollution;

WHEREAS, the Air Quality Monitoring System Equipment requested shall have the following descriptions, to wit:

1. One (1) unit - Air Quality Monitoring System Equipment

Specifications:

Spectrometer, continuous environmental fine dust 19"; rack monitor with 187 Spectrometer for simultaneous measurement of PM10 and PM2.5; Gas sampling probe system; Ambient NO/NO2/Nox analyser; ambient SO2/H2S Analyzer; internal ozone penetrator and internal zero air; for API T700; T701 zero air scrubber; met sensors; stationary mini shelter single B IP54.

GRAND TOTAL: PhP19,500,000.00

WHEREAS, the procurement of the said equipment for Air Quality Monitoring System is in accordance with the City's development and environmental care; ✱

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


NOW, THEREFORE,


