RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6909, S-2016

A RESOLUTION URGING THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE-QUEZON CITY TO RECOMMEND THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES AS A FIELD TRIP SITE OF ALL QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS, CONTINGENT UPON ADHERENCE TO ORDINANCE NO. SP-2296, S-2014, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE EDUCATIONAL FIELD TRIP POLICY FOR ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN QUEZON CITY".

WHEREAS, Section 15 Article XIV, of the Constitution provides that the State shall "conserve, promote, and popularize the nation's historical, cultural and artistic heritage";

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Ordinance No. SP-2296, S-2014 known as "An Ordinance Establishing the Educational Field Trip Policy for All Public Schools in Quezon City," provides that "field trips must have as their goal the enhancement of student knowledge and skills, as well as complementing and supplementing the adopted curriculum";

WHEREAS, the National Museum of the Philippines (National Museum) exhibits a diverse collection of the rich history, culture, and arts of the Filipino people;

WHEREAS, a policy of free general admission has been established, which took effect last July 1, 2016, by the Board of Trustees of the National Museum, in order to build upon significant spikes in viewership, especially among young Filipinos, that have been observed in 2013-2015 and to date in 2016, when general admission has been made free of charge for various traditional reasons such as National Arts Month in February, National Heritage Month in May, and National Museums and Galleries Month in October;

WHEREAS, a tour of the National Museum, where we proudly exhibit national patrimony and heritage, will complement the history subject of students and instill in them patriotism and pride for the country.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Schools Division Office-Quezon City to recommend the National Museum of the Philippines as a field trip site of all Quezon City public schools, contingent upon adherence to Ordinance No. SP-2296, S-2014, entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing the Educational Field Trip Policy for All Public Schools in Quezon City."

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Schools Division Office-Quezon City and to the National Museum of the Philippines.
