WHEREAS, the bill intends to be known as the "Bicycle Act of 2016" which seeks "to establish bike-friendly communities throughout the Philippines";


NOW, THEREFORE,


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of House Bill No. 2276 be made an integral part of this Resolution.
