A RESOLUTION URGING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO) TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10586, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ANTI-DRUNK AND DRUGGED DRIVING ACT OF 2013.

WHEREAS, the National Government has already approved Republic Act No. 10586 which penalizes the acts of driving under the influence of alcohol, dangerous drugs and other intoxicating substances and shall inculcate the standards of safe driving and the benefits that may be derived from it through institutional programs and appropriate public information strategies;

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Office (LTO) is mandated to prioritize and diligently implement the provisions of the Republic Act No. 10586 or the "Anti-Drunk and Drugged driving act of 2013";

WHEREAS, the said law not only penalizes the commission of the aforesaid act but also the peace and order, safety and harmony of various area in this city and to support the implementation of the said Act;

WHEREAS, to carry out the aforementioned objectives, it is necessary to urge the LTO to strictly implement Republic Act No. 10586 so as to control drug abuse problem, if there is any, may cause significant physical, mental or social dysfunction that affects not only the driver but also his/her passenger and the people around.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Land Transportation Office to strictly implement Republic Act No. 10586, otherwise known as the "Anti-Drunk and Drugged Driving Act of 2013".
