WHEREAS, City Sisterhood and Town Twinning is a broad-based, officially approved, long-term partnership between local governments within the country and abroad. It is the highest form of inter - local government unit partnership, in a sense forging local government exchange and cooperation in the pursuit of mutually beneficial objectives along socio-cultural and economic aspects of development;

WHEREAS, the proposed sister-city relationship between the two great cities of historical background and which have been devoting unquantifiable concern and attention in promoting general welfare will further enhance their respective local governance towards socio-cultural, trade and economic development;

WHEREAS, both cities, in accordance with their prevailing laws, and regulations, establish a sister-city cooperation to promote and expand an effective and mutually beneficial cooperation in the development of both cities, within the limits of their financial, material and personnel capabilities in the following fields:

- a. Trade and economic development;
- b. Transportation and tourism;
- c. Education, culture, youth and sports;
- d. Environment and urban management; and
- e. Human resources, science and technology.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Quezon City Government to foster friendship, trade, understanding and cooperation;


WHEREAS, the draft Memorandum of Understanding shall form an integral part of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE,




