A RESOLUTION TASKING THE BARANGAY OPERATIONS CENTER, CITY BUDGET DEPARTMENT AND THE OFFICE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY WILL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2355, S-2014, ORDINANCE NO. SP-2351, S-2014, AND ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2339, S-2014.

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2355, S-2014, entitled "An Ordinance Authorizing Every Barangay In Quezon City To Set Aside One Percent (1%) Of Their Total Annual Budget And To Allocate The Same For The Programs, Projects, And Activities For Senior Citizens And Persons With Disabilities.", authorizes all barangays in Quezon City to set aside at least one percent (1%) of its total annual budget and allocate the same for worthy programs, projects, and activities of senior citizens;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. SP-2351, S-2014, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Senior Citizens' Desk In Every Barangay In Quezon City To Be Designated As "Barangay Senior Citizens' Desk" And Appropriating Funds Thereto", requires the establishment of a Senior Citizens' Desk in every barangay in Quezon City for easier and speedy facilitation and channelling of services to our resident senior citizens;


WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. SP- 2339, S-2014, entitled "An Ordinance Mandating Every Barangay In Quezon City To Establish A "Barangay Senior Citizens Center", And Appropriating Funds Thereto", mandates all barangays to establish a Senior Citizens Center in their respective barangays to serve as a venue where our resident senior citizens may stage their programs, projects, and activities;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Resolution No. SP-5888, S-2014, intends to make Quezon City as "Senior Citizens Friendly City".


NOW, THEREFORE,
