A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO PETRON CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A GASOLINE FILLING STATION WHICH SHALL BE LOCATED AT CONGRESSIONAL AVENUE EXTENSION, BARANGAY PASONG TAMO, DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, petitioner "Petron Corporation", a business entity duly registered under Philippine Laws, is applying for a Special Use Permit (SUP) to be used for the construction and operation of a gasoline filling station which shall be located at Congressional Avenue Extension, Barangay Pasong Tamo, District VI, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Pasong Tamo interposes no objection to the proposed construction, because of the benefits and development that would be realized out of the said project and a public hearing was properly conducted and obtained favorable approval from the residents therein;


WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, otherwise known as the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, a Special Use Permit is required for this project;

WHEREAS, "Petron Corporation" has complied with the necessary requirements for the issuance of a Special Use Permit as mandated by the aforementioned Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE,


