RESOLUTION NO. SP- **7033**, S-2017

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) ENTERED INTO BY AND AMONG THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (LGU-QC), REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MORONG (LGU-MORONG), REPRESENTED BY MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HONORABLE ARMANDO SAN JUAN, AND NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY (NHA), REPRESENTED BY ITS GENERAL MANAGER, HONORABLE MARCELINO P. ESCALADA, JR., FOR THE EXCLUSIVE ALLOCATION OF ALL NHA RELOCATION SLOTS IN MORONG, RIZAL TO QUALIFIED INFORMAL SETTLERS FAMILIES (ISFS) RELOCATEES FROM QUEZON CITY AND THE GRANTING OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT ASSISTANCE BY LGU-QC TO LGU-MORONG AMOUNTING TO TWENTY MILLION PESOS (PHP20,000,000.00), EARMARKED FOR THE BASIC SERVICES AND ASSISTANCE REQUIREMENTS OF THE RELOCATED ISFS FROM QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, under the re-settlement program of the National Government, the LGU-QC has relocated its informal settler families (ISFs) to the resettlement sites of the National Housing Authority (NHA) situated in the Municipality of Morong Rizal;

WHEREAS, the LGU-Morong has agreed in receiving ISFs-relocatees to NHA resettlement sites situated within its territorial jurisdiction, however, due to its limited resources and budgetary constraints to provide and sustain the essential needs of the relocatees, it has solicited support from the sending LGU;

WHEREAS, to be able to minimize solicitation and negotiations for support with sending LGUs, LGU-MORONG has requested NHA to exclusively allocate to LGU-QC all relocation slots situated within its territorial jurisdiction, numbering to about 3,100 housing units;

WHEREAS, LGU-QC is well aware that to live a humane life at the relocation site, the resettled ISFs would need to have access to essential needs such as basic education, health, basic utilities, affordable transportation, peace and order and livelihood programs;

WHEREAS, pending the availability and provision of the complete basic services to the relocation ISFs, as mandated under the resettlement program of the national government, LGU-QC has agreed to provide financial support assistance to LGU-MORONG in the amount of Twenty Million Pesos (Php20,000,000.00), which amount can be broken down to Php6,452.00 per relocated ISF, an amount comparatively lower than the 60 days minimum wage requirement (approximately Php30,000.00 per ISF) mandated by R.A No. 7279;

WHEREAS, the said financial support assistance fund shall cover expenses for the improvement of resettlement sites, acquisition of lots for and construction of social infrastructure facilities such as multi-purpose centers, acquisition of service vehicles and garbage truck, skills trainings, livelihood, as well as education and health services program;

WHEREAS, the NHA, after due consideration of the request of LGU-MORONG and the commitment for support assistance by LGU-QC, has agreed to allocate all its relocation slots located in the Municipality of Morong Rizal, to qualified ISFs-relocatees from Quezon City; ✓

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WHEREAS, the parties have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for the exclusive allocation of all NHA relocation slots in Morong, Rizal, to qualified ISFs-relocatees from Quezon City and the granting of financial support assistance amounting to Twenty Million Pesos to LGU-MORONG by LGU-QC, earmarked for the basic services and assistance requirements of the relocated ISFs from Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) entered into by and among the Quezon City Government (LGU-QC), represented by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, Municipal Government of Morong (LGU-MORONG), represented by Municipal Mayor, Honorable Armando San Juan, and National Housing Authority (NHA), represented by its General Manager, Honorable Marcelino P. Escalada, Jr., for the exclusive allocation of all NHA relocation slots in Morong, Rizal to qualified ISFs relocatees from Quezon City and the granting of financial support assistance by LGU-QC to LGU-MORONG amounting to Twenty Million Pesos (Php20,000,000.00), earmarked for the basic services and assistance requirements of the relocated ISFs from Quezon City.
