WHEREAS, the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) has commenced voters' registration for the May 2022 elections on January of this year until September 30, 2021;

WHEREAS, voters' registration was suspended in March due to the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, the COMELEC re-opened the voters' registration last September 1, 2020 but further announced that there will be no satellite voters' registration;

WHEREAS, satellite voters' registration affords the members of society who have reached the age of majority the encouragement and convenience in performing the first step in order to exercise the right to vote and fulfill a duty of a Filipino citizen.




