RESOLUTION NO. SP- 7114 , S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL TO USE THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FORTY PESOS AND SIXTY CENTAVOS (PHP132,805,940.60) FROM THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND TO PURCHASE VARIOUS EQUIPMENT FOR THE USE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, MEDICAL SERVICES AND ANCILLARY/PARAMEDICAL SERVICES OF THE HOSPITAL WHICH ARE URGENTLY NEEDED TO PROVIDE QUALITY HEALTH AND HOSPITAL CARE SERVICES TO PATIENTS AND TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS NEEDED BY THE HOSPITAL IN MAINTAINING ITS HIGHEST LEVEL OF LICENSING WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital is a level III, 250-bed tertiary, training hospital owned and operated by the Quezon City Government which aims to provide hospital services to the residents of Quezon City especially the poor;

WHEREAS, for the past four years there is no approved appropriation for the purchase of equipment in the City Executive Budget for the Quezon City General Hospital;

WHEREAS, there is a need to purchase equipment to replace worn out instruments and equipment which are beyond repair;

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WHEREAS, the Bureau of Licensing and Regulation of the Department of Health has required that all the said equipment be made available to ensure the safety of patients and to maintain the hospital status as a first class Level III hospital, the highest standard given by the Department of Health to a hospital;

WHEREAS, the accountant of the Quezon City General Hospital has certified that the amount of One Hundred Thirty Two Million Pesos Eight Hundred Five Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Pesos and Sixty Centavos (Php132,805,940.60) is available in the Hospital Development Fund for the purchase of the badly needed equipment.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City General Hospital, to use the One Hundred Thirty Two Million Eight Hundred Five Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Pesos and Sixty Centavos (Php132,805,940.60) from the Hospital Development Fund to purchase the various hospital equipment for the use of the administrative services, medical services and ancillary / paramedical services of the hospital which are urgently needed to provide quality health and hospital care services to patients and to meet the requirements needed by the hospital in maintaining its highest level of licensing with the Department of Health.
