A RESOLUTION URGING THE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (TESDA) TO EXPAND THEIR PROGRAMS IN PROVIDING TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT IN EVERY BARANGAY TO AFFORD THE OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTH (OSY) THE OPPORTUNITY TO ENHANCE THEIR CAPABILITIES AS A MEANS OF IMPROVING THEIR ECONOMIC CONDITION.
