RESOLUTION NO. SP.____7163__, S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO APPROPRIATE THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY NINE MILLION NINE HUNDRED NINETY NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY SEVEN PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (PHP29,999,997.50) FOR THE PROVISION OF FOOD FOR THE DETAINED OFFENDERS IN QUEZON CITY JAIL.

WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government shall be through public bidding;

WHEREAS, under Section 455 (b) (1) (vi), of the same Code provides that "the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, in the case of Hon. Quisumbing vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527), the Supreme Court requires the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursement charged against lump sum appropriation can be made;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Jail is requesting for a City Council Resolution for the purchase of food for the detained offenders specifically described as follows:
