RESOLUTION NO. SP. 7190 , S-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH ANY HOSPITAL WITHIN QUEZON CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO AILING RESIDENTS AND INDIGENT PATIENTS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Sections 17 (b) (4) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" provides that the local government units shall exercise powers, functions, and responsibilities necessary and appropriate to provide basic health services to their constituents, which include the implementation of programs and projects on primary health care, maternal and child care, communicable and non-communicable disease control services, access to secondary and tertiary health services, purchase of medicines, medical supplies and equipment;

WHEREAS, it has been the constant policy of the Quezon City Government to provide health and social services available at affordable cost to all residents, and to accord medical care to paupers;

WHEREAS, Quezon City is the prime location of various outstanding private and government hospitals in Metro Manila that have facilities and physicians to cater to the medical services needed by ailing residents and indigent patients requesting for medical assistance;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is sought by numerous sick residents for assistance regarding their medical conditions and financial constraints to address their health concerns;

WHEREAS, to relatively address these issues, authorization must be given to the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into contract or Memorandum of Agreement with any reputable hospital in Quezon City for the purpose of providing medical aid to our people who are ill;

WHEREAS, under the Contract or Memorandum of Agreement that the Mayor is authorized to enter, a specified fund will be deposited to the associate hospital, and such fund will be utilized for the medical expenses of our ailing underprivileged residents.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a Contract or Memorandum of Agreement with any Hospital within Quezon City for the purpose of providing Medical Assistance to ailing residents and indigent patients of the city.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Contract or Memorandum of Agreement that the City Mayor is authorized to enter, shall be limited to a scheme of depositing a specified fund in the partner hospital, and said fund shall be utilized for the hospital expenses of residents requesting medical assistance from the Quezon City Government.
