A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. SP-7027, S-2017, AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE TWELVE (12) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO DISTRICT VI QUEZON CITY PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS TO BE CHARGED TO THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR MARIVIC CO PILAR.
