RESOLUTION NO. SP. 7334 , S-2017

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A SPECIAL PERMIT TO TOTAL GAMEZONE XTREME, INC. TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES ESTABLISHMENT AT THE 2ND FLOOR OF DON ANTONIO SPORTS CENTER, BLOCK 17, LOT 5, HOLY SPIRIT DRIVE, BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT, COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, Total Gamezone Xtreme, Inc., a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, is applying for a special permit to operate an Electronic Games Establishment located at the 2nd Floor of Don Antonio Sports Center, Block 17, Lot 5, Holy Spirit Drive, Barangay Holy Spirit, Commonwealth Ave., Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate the aforesaid Electronic Games, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2285, S-2014, in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the city government, thereby boosting the city's economy for the welfare of its inhabitants.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant a Special Permit to Total Gamezone Xtreme, Inc., to operate an Electronic Games Establishment at the 2nd Floor of Don Antonio Sports Center, Block 17, Lot 5, Holy Spirit Drive, Barangay Holy Spirit, Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Games Establishment granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The holding of Electronic Games shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
- The operation of Electronic Games shall not include the playing of games not related to Electronic Games;
- c. The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below eighteen (18) years of age from playing in the above-mentioned games; and
- d. The operator/applicant shall remit to the City Treasurer a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable to the City Treasury during the lifetime of the measure

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that this Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games Establishment shall be valid for a period of two (2) years from the approval of this Resolution and maybe renewed by the City Council.
