WHEREAS, Ka-Freddie is a multi-awarded singer/composer known for his rendition of "Bayan Ko", which became the anthem for the opposition to the Marcos regime during the 1986 People Power Revolution and for his song "Anak", which has been translated into 26 languages with different versions, sold throughout the Philippines, United States, Europe and Asia;

WHEREAS, most of Ka-Freddie's songs convey social and political messages, namely: "Magdalena", "Katarungan", "Mindanao", "Luzviminda" and "Para sa Tunay na Pagbabago" which continuously plays a pivotal role in promoting Filipino music and nationalism;
