WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is committed to uphold and protect the rights of children and shall pursue programs and mechanisms to ensure the survival, development, protection, and participation of children as mandated by the Constitution;

WHEREAS, in 2012, the Quezon City Council enacted the Quezon City Children's Code to recognize and uphold the rights of all children and to establish a local development plan;

WHEREAS, as provided under the Quezon City Children's Code, the Quezon City Council for the Protection of Children (QCCPC) is mandated to formulate the City's Local Development Plan for Children;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 45, S-2019, as amended by Executive Order No. 42-A, S-2019 and Executive Order No. 42-B, S-2020, reconstituted the Quezon City Council for the Protection of Children (QCCPC) and was tasked to formulate the City's Local Development Plan for Children and the Medium-Term Investment Plan for Children for the years 2021-2025;

WHEREAS, the City's Local Development Plan for Children focuses on the four (4) categories of Child's Rights: Survival, Development, Protection and Participation;

WHEREAS, the City's Local Development Plan for Children is the reiteration of the Quezon City's commitment to create a child-friendly city that protects the rights of children, in compliance with the Convention of the Rights of the Child;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council for the Protection of Children approved the City's Local Development Plan for Children and the Medium-Term Investment Plan for Children for 2021-2025 on July 28, 2021 under Resolution No. 1, Series of 2021;

WHEREAS, the QCCPC also passed Resolution No. 2, Series of 2021, requesting the City Council to adopt the said Local Development Plan for Children for 2021-2025;

WHEREAS, this Resolution adopts the City's Local Development Plan for Children and the Medium-Term Investment Plan for Children to ensure the effective implementation of the proposed programs and projects therein.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to adopt, as it does hereby adopt, the 21st Quezon City Council's Local Development Plan for Children and the Medium-Term Investment Plan for Children for 2021-2025.
