A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ACCEPT THE DONATION FROM GOLDEN ABC, INCORPORATED FOR THE DONATION OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (250) VIALS (2,500 DOSES) OF ASTRAZENECA COVID-19 VACCINES FOR THE INOCULATION OF RESIDENTS AND WORKERS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the local government of Quezon City to extend partnership and cooperation with humanitarian organizations and private entities in addressing health issues which affect its constituents;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is committed to collaborate with various stakeholders in its efforts to prevent, mitigate, and contain the spread of COVID-19 within its territorial jurisdiction;

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WHEREAS, to combat the COVID-19 pandemic, the Quezon City Government is inoculating the residents and workers in Quezon City with COVID-19 vaccines duly approved by the National Government;

WHEREAS, Golden ABC, Incorporated has expressed its desire to assist the Quezon City Government's COVID-19 response by donating its company procured COVID-19 vaccines pursuant to the tripartite agreement with AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals Philippines Inc., National Government (Task Force Against COVID-19) and Go Negosyo, to wit:

WHEREAS, the civic spirit and generosity during this time of the COVID-19 pandemic by the officers of the Golden ABC, Incorporated is greatly appreciated by the City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to accept the donation from Golden ABC, Incorporated for the donation of two hundred fifty (250) vials (2,500 doses) of AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccines for the inoculation of residents and workers in Quezon City.

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RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Deed of Donation shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
