BELMONTE, TO PURCHASE AND DONATE ONE (1) UNIT OF MOTOR VEHICLE TO THE PHILIPPINE DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCY (PDEA), QUEZON CITY DISTRICT OFFICE, INTENDED FOR THE MONITORING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THEIR PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE APPROVED FUNDS OF THE PEACE AND ORDER AND PUBLIC SAFETY PLAN OF THE CITY.
