AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE ACQUISITION OF GOODS AND SERVICES THROUGH ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT

WHEREAS, on 1 December 2020, the President of the Philippines signed Executive Order No. 121 which approved the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for drugs and vaccines against the Covid-19 disease;

WHEREAS, on 10 January 2021, the City has signed a tripartite agreement with the National Government, through the National Task Force against Covid-19 and the Department of Health, other Local Government Units and AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals (Phils.) Inc. for the supply of Astrazeneca Covid-19 Vaccines for the benefit of the Filipino people;

WHEREAS, the City's COVID-19 vaccination program necessitates the procurement of Cold Chain services for One Million One Hundred Thousand (1,100,000) doses of COVID-19 vaccines which are to be stored at 2°C to 8°C;

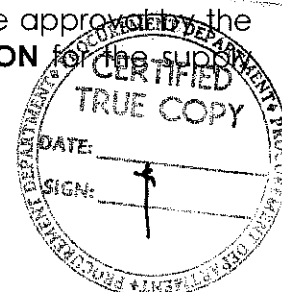
WHEREAS, in its Resolution No. 03-44 Series of 2021 duly approved by the City Mayor, the Bids and Awards Committee on Goods and Services (the "Committee") recommended the use of negotiated mode as an alternative method of procurement for Cold Chain Management Services For Coronavirus Disease 2019 Vaccines (the "Project") pursuant to Section 53.2, of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184, states among others that negotiated procurement may be resorted to when time is of the essence arising from other causes where immediate action is necessary to prevent damage to or loss of life or property; and

WHEREAS, on MAR 29 2021, the CITY sent Requests for Quotation to various service providers of known qualification;


