



**RESOLUTION NO. 21-A-244**

**AWARDING THE RENEWAL OF CONTRACT FOR INTERNET SERVICES  
THROUGH ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee on Goods (the “**Committee**”) conducted a public competitive bidding for the procurement of Supply and Delivery of Tablets, Mobile Prepaid LTE Sim Cards and Quezon City WiFi Service for Distance Learning Modality of Schools Division Office – Quezon City Hall (the “**Project**”) Line 2 (“**Data Allocation**”).

**WHEREAS**, the Quezon City Schools Division Office (the “end-user”), as end-user of the Project, submitted a letter request to the BAC-Goods and Services, and requested for the extension of the Project insofar as the internet services is concerned to ensure a continued provision of internet services that are needed by the elementary and secondary students of the City;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 3.3.1.2 of Appendix 21 of the IRR of R.A 9184, the end-user evaluated the quality of service provided by the **SUPPLIER** and found the same satisfactory which met the standards required by the City;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 3.3.1.3 of Appendix 21 of the IRR of R.A 9184, the end-user also conducted a cost benefit analysis based on the quotations previously submitted by capable service providers in the area, and concluded that renewing the existing contract with the **SUPPLIER** under the same terms and conditions will be the most advantageous to the City, as supported by the following justifications:

1. The **SUPPLIER** offers the longest data validity period. The longer validity period of allocated data is advantageous to students as the uneven use of data in completing performance tasks and assessments allows the maximum use of the package;
2. The **SUPPLIER** offers a blacklisting of website feature. The Blacklisting feature is essential as it ensures that the data is utilized for studying and school related activities; and
3. The **SUPPLIER** offers the 10GB of allocated data compared to other offers of only 2 Gb. Greater Data allocation allows for more multimedia content access and asynchronous activities allowance for students.

**WHEREAS**, based on the result of conducted cost-benefit analysis and assessments of the quality of service provided by the **SUPPLIER**, the end-user recommended the renewal of contract for internet services;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC - Goods and Services concluded that the basis of the request for renewal is reasonable and compliant with the requirements and conditions set forth in Appendix 21 of the IRR of Republic Act No. 9184 Guidelines on Procurement of Water, Electricity, Telecommunications and Internet Service Providers, as amended by GPPB Resolution No. 41-2017;

**WHEREAS**, in its Resolution No.04-71B Series of 2021 duly approved by the City Mayor, the Committee recommended the use of direct contracting as a method of renewing the Project pursuant to Section 50 (b), RIRR of RA 9184 which provides that when the procurement of critical components from a specific supplier is a condition precedent to hold a contractor to guarantee its project performance, in accordance with the provisions of its contract; and





