WHEREAS, the Miriam College and Quezon City University are both Higher Educational Institutions and are both eager to collaborate in the project implementation of Education Development Center, Inc.'s (EDC) Opportunity 2.0;

WHEREAS, in said collaboration, the Miriam College is the implementing Higher Educational Institution of the Training Program and Project, entitled "Capacitating HEIs in Developing and Implementing Holistic and Relevant Programs for Out-of-School Youth" and the Quezon City Government, through the Quezon City University, will be the recipient of the training program;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Miriam College for the project implementation of the EDC Opportunity 2.0 under the Strengthening Education, Employment and Development Support (SEEDS).
