RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8830**, S-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BARAS, PROVINCE OF RIZAL IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP2,500,000.00) FOR THE BENEFIT OF RELOCATED INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFs) COMING FROM QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the state to provide the people with adequate and decent housing facilities and to encourage various stakeholders to participate in the program of the government;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 90 dated December 17, 1986 mandated the National Housing Authority (NHA) as the sole production agency to meet the housing needs of the low and marginalized families in the urban and urbanizing areas;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and Republic Act No. 7279, otherwise known as the Urban Development and Housing Act of 1992, Local Government Units are mandated to take a principal role in the provision of housing services to its constituents;

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*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government will be relocating its informal settler families (ISFs) to the resettlement site of the National Housing Authority situated in the Municipality of Baras, Province of Rizal;*

*WHEREAS, the Municipality of Baras, Province of Rizal, has agreed to accommodate the ISFs-relocatees from Quezon City to NHA Resettlement Site situated within its territorial jurisdiction, but due to its limited resources and budgetary constraints to provide and sustain the essential needs of the relocatees, there is a need for financial support from the sending LGU;*

*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is well aware that to live a humane life at the relocation site, the resettled ISFs need to have an access to the basic needs such as education, health, permanent utility services, affordable transportation, peace and order and livelihood programs;*

*WHEREAS, pending the availability and provision of post relocation assistances and services mandated under the resettlement program of the national government, the Quezon City Government agrees to provide support services in the areas of education, health, permanent utility services, affordable transportation, peace and order and livelihood programs to the Municipal Government of Baras, Province of Rizal;*

*WHEREAS, the National Housing Authority has allocated and certified the availability of the units for the relocation of informal settler families (ISFs) coming from Quezon City;*

*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government shall provide assistance for the programs, projects and activities of the Municipality of Baras, Province of Rizal, within five (5) years (2020-2025) and both parties will mutually agree on the mode of assistance that would address such needs;*

*WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.*

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to grant financial assistance to the Municipality of Baras, Province of Rizal, in the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php2,500,000.00) for the benefit of relocated informal settler families (ISFs) coming from Quezon City.
