RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8904**, S-2022

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF B-7 AMUSEMENTS CORPORATION TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC BINGO (E-BINGO), TRADITIONAL BINGO AND ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) AT CIRCLE C CENTER, CONGRESSIONAL AVENUE, BARANGAY BAHAY TORO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, B-7 Amusements Corporation is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with business address at Circle C Center, Congressional Avenue, Barangay Bahay Toro, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, B-7 Amusements Corporation is primarily engaged in the business of Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo), Traditional Bingo and Electronic Games (E-Games);

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate an Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo), Traditional Bingo and Electronic Games (E-Games) in Quezon City, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to existing ordinance in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, B-7 Amusements Corporation is requesting the City Council for the renewal of a Special Permit to operate an Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo), Traditional Bingo and Electronic Games (E-Games).


