RESOLUTION NO. N008; S-2021

RECOMMENDING AWARD OF NEGOTIATED CONTRACT DECLARING THE SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID

- whereas, on 08 March 2020, Proclamation No. 922 entitled "Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines" was signed and Section 5 of which provides that the State of Public Health Emergency shall remain in force and effect until lifted or withdrawn by the President.
- WHEREAS, on 09 March 2020, GPPB Resolution No. 03-2020 entitled "Approving the Adoption of Efficient, Effective, and Expedient Procurement Procedures during a State of Public Health Emergency" was approved.
- WHEREAS, on 16 March 2020, Proclamation No. 929 entitled "Declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease 2019" was signed.
- WHEREAS, 24 March 2020 Republic Act No. 11469 entitled "An act declaring the existence of a National Emergency arising from the Corona Virus Disease of 2019 (COVID-19) situation and a National Policy in connection therewith and authorizing the president of the Republic of the Philippines for a limited period and subject to restrictions to exercise powers necessary and proper to carry out the declared National Policy and for other purposes";
- WHEREAS, on 26 March 2020, Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 entitled "Emergency Procurement by the Government during a State of Public Health Emergency Arising from the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (CoViD-19)" was issued by the Commission on Audit (COA) and the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB).
- WHEREAS, on 11 September 2020 Republic Act No. 11494 entitled "An act providing for COVID-19 response and recovery interventions and providing mechanism to accelerate the recovery and bolster the resiliency of the Philippine economy, providing funds therefor, and for other purposes";
- WHEREAS, on 16 September 2020 Proclamation No. 1021 was issued extending the period of State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 declared under Proclamation No. 929, effective 13 September 2020 to 12 September 2021;
- WHEREAS, on 10 September 2020 Proclamation No. 1218 was issued extending further the period of State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 declared under Proclamation No. 1021, effective 13 September 2021 to 12 September 2022
- WHEREAS, Section 3.1 on General Provisions of the aforementioned Circular provides that, to further support the Government's efforts to mitigate, if not contain the transmission of CoVID-19 in the country, the GPPB issued Resolution Nos. 03-2020 and 05-2020 to simplify and streamline the Rules on Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases) modality

embodied in Section 53 (b) or RA No. 9184 and Section 53.2 of its 2016 IRR, as an exemption to Public Bidding under R.A. 9184, and enable Procuring Entities to efficiently and expediently undertake procurement during a State of Public Health Emergency;

WHEREAS.

Section 3.2 on General Provisions of the same Circular provides that, during the state of Public Health Emergency declared by the President Procuring Entities are allowed to resort to Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases) under Section 53 (b) of R.A. No. 9184, Section 53.2 of its 2016 IRR and associated issuances for the procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services that are directly related to the mitigation and containment of the transmission of COVID-19, in order for Procuring Entities to properly and timely respond to this Public Health Emergency;

WHEREAS.

Section 53 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act provides that: Negotiated Procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services, whereby the procuring Entity may directly negotiate a contract with technically, legally and financially capable supplier, contractor or consultant;

WHEREAS,

Section 53.2 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act provides that: In case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or other causes where immediate action is necessary to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public series, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities. In the case of Infrastructure Projects, the Procuring Entity has the option undertake the project through negotiated procurement;

WHEREAS,

various contractors were invited to submit bid proposals for the above named project and the same responded accordingly by submitting their corresponding bid proposals within the deadline stated in the Request for Quotation;

WHEREAS,

upon evaluation of proposals submitted, the following bids were determined as lowest calculated and responsive bids for the corresponding projects:

This Contract made and entered in Quezon City, Metro Manila, this day of FEB 16 2022 , by and between:

QUEZON CITY, a public corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at City Hall, Diliman, Quezon City, Metro Manila and herein represented by MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, in her capacity as City Mayor, herein after referred to as the QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT;

- and -

MCP ENTERPRISE & GEN. CONTRACTOR INC. a domestic company duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal Office at Blk 31 Lot 3 Matthew Street, North Olympus Phase 1, Barangay 172 Dist. 1, Caloocan City and herein represented by MR. MITCHELLE C. PALOS in his capacity as PRESIDENT hereinafter referred to as the CONTRACTOR;

WHEREAS, the QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT is desirous that the Contractor execute for the PROPOSED REHABILITATION OF RECEPTION AREA AT VARIOUS HEALTH CENTER (DISTRICT 6 - CLUSTER 2), BARANGAY TALIPAPA with PROJECT NO. 21-070N and the City has accepted the Bid for TWO HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN PESOS ONLY (P 240,517.00) by the Contractor for the execution and completion of such Works and the remedying of any defects therein.

 - (f) Notice of Award of Contract and the Bidder's conforme thereto;
 - (g) Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Entity.



- 3. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Contractor as hereinafter mentioned, the Contractor hereby covenants with the Entity to execute and complete the Works and remedy any defects therein in conformity with the provisions of this Contract in all respects.
- The Entity hereby covenants to pay the Contractor in consideration of the 4. execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of defects wherein. the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of this Contract at the times and in the manner prescribed by this Contract.
- 5. That the Contractor hereby certifies that the site was regularly inspected and verified
- 6. The Contractor further undertakes to implement the awarded project in accordance with the approved plans, specifications and cost of contract.
