



RESOLUTION NO. B005; S - 2021

DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDS AND RECOMMENDING APPROVAL FOR CONTRACT AWARDS

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the Bids and Awards Committee for Infrastructure (QC-BAC-Infra) downloaded an Invitation to Bid (ITB) dated June 21, 2021 in the Phil-GEPS and at conspicuous places in Quezon City Hall for the public bidding to be held on July 12, 2021, for fifteen (15) infrastructure projects of the City Government;

WHEREAS, a total of thirty two (32) Document Request List (DRL) to participate were received from prospective contractors and were issued bid documents;

WHEREAS, during the scheduled public bidding held on July 12, 2021, thirty two (32) bid proposals were received and opened and, after examination of said documents, thirty (30) were declared passed and their corresponding bid price read while four (4) were declared failed;

WHEREAS, by virtue of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, the BAC determines that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid/Highest Rated Bid fails the criteria for post-qualification, it shall immediately notify the said bidder in writing of its post-disqualification and the grounds for it;

WHEREAS, evaluation of all bids received and rated passed and post-qualification of bidders with the lowest calculated bid submitted for each specific project have been conducted as prescribed in the Revised IRR of RA 9184;

NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED by the QC-BAC-Infra & Consultancy to declare the following bidders as having the lowest calculated and responsive bids submitted for the corresponding projects bid out by the QC-BAC-Infra & Consultancy on July 12, 2021:

INOCENCIO P. CARAG** in his capacity as **PRESIDENT** hereinafter referred to as the **CONTRACTOR**;

WHEREAS, the QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT is desirous that the Contractor execute for the **PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT OF BAHAY KALINGA BUILDING (INTEGRATED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CENTER AND CALALAY TRAINING CENTER), BARANGAY N.S. AMORANTO & PROJECT NO. 21-00083** and the City has accepted the Bid for **THIRTY MILLION THREE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE PESOS & 70/100 CTVS. (P 30,305,595.70)** by the Contractor for the execution and completion of such Works and the remedying of any defects therein.

6. The Contractor further undertakes to implement the awarded project in accordance with the approved plans, specifications and cost of contract.




