TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

COMPREHENSIVE RAPID ENGLISH LITERACY, FILPINO LITERACY, NUMERACY, AND SEL (SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING) ASSESSMENT FOR KINDER, GRADE 1, GRADE 2, AND GRADE 3 LEARNERS OF SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE OF QUEZON CITY

I. RATIONALE AND BRIEF BACKGROUND

In School Year 2022-2023, the Department of Education started the implementation of limited face to face classes and eventually will shift to full face to face classes before the year ends in all public elementary and secondary schools. To support the Department of Education Order No. 34 series of 2022, the Rapid Assessment on fundamental skills will be utilize in the direction of the learning recovery and continuity plan.

II. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

To support the Department of Education's learning continuity and recovery plan and to ascertain that our students have equal access to quality education, the City proposes the provision to utilized Rapid Assessment in order to determine learning gaps or learning loss among our learners and to provide further remediation and intervention. The information from rapid assessment captures learners fundamental skills on literacy and numeracy that are needed to be successful in other learning areas.

III. PROJECT SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. Coordinate with the personnel of the SDO Quezon City in the administration and set up requirements of the assessment.
- 2. Provide the results of the Rapid English Literacy, Filipino Literacy, Numeracy, and SEL (Social and Emotional Learning) Assessment to SDO Quezon City within 5 to 14 days.
- 3. Conduct the scoring, interpreting, and consolidating of results, soft copy, to SDO Quezon City after the conduct of the scheduled assessment;
- 4. Provide the interventions and training needed to be based on the Rapid English Literacy, Filipino Literacy, Numeracy, and SEL (Social and Emotional Learning) Assessment to SDO Quezon City.

IV. AREA OF COVERAGE

The Assessment will be utilized in all Kinder, Grade 1, Grade 2, and Grade 3 Students in Quezon City Public Elementary Schools.

V. PROJECT STANDARD AND REQUIREMENTS

The Service Provider shall be eligible to participate in the bidding process, provided that they meet the following qualifications;

1. The Service Provider must have partnered with government or private agencies that is similar in nature to this project with the last three (3) years,

X. CANCELLATION OF TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The guidelines contained in RA 90184 and its revised IRR shall be followed in the termination of any service contract. In the even the City terminated the Contract due to default insolvency, or for cause, it may enter into negotiated procurement pursuant to section 53 (d) of RA 9184 and its IRR.
