



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22
Series of 2019

CREATING THE QUEZON CITY C40 CITIES FINANCE FACILITY
TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG)

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 9513 otherwise known as an Act Promoting the Development, Utilization and Commercialization of Renewable Energy Resources and for Other Purposes was approved into law in 2008 to legislate state policy to accelerate the development and use of renewable energy resources;

WHEREAS, EPMC Resolution No. 2015-02 otherwise known as A Resolution Granting Approval of the Solar Energy Project in Quezon City Public Schools and Creation of the Technical Working Group (TWG) for this Purpose was adopted and approved in 2015 for the creation of a TWG for the conduct of complete staff work for the implementation of the Solar Energy Project in Quezon City Public Schools;

WHEREAS, Quezon City has been granted a Technical Assistance (TA) from the C40 Cities Finance Facility for the implementation of the Solarization of Fifty (50) Public Schools project;

WHEREAS, the project involves the installation of a Grid-Tied Photo Voltaic (PV) system in 50 selected public schools in Quezon City to reduce electricity consumption and Greenhouse Gas Emissions;

WHEREAS, the TA is a two-year engagement covering a wide range of technical support including technical feasibility studies for rooftop solar projects and development of public private partnership models;

WHEREAS, there is a need to create a dedicated TWG to conduct detailed evaluation and assessment of public schools and identify suitable solar power system to utilize.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, Mayor of Quezon City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and direct:

SECTION 1. CREATION AND COMPOSITION. There shall be created a Technical Working Group on the Quezon City C40 Cities Finance Facility and shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson:

Head, City General Services Department

Vice Chairperson:

Head, Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department

Members:

City Administrator or his authorized representative

Head, Department of the Building Official

Head, City Engineering Department

Head, Task Force Streetlights

Head, Quezon City Division of City Schools

The EPWMD shall act as the Secretariat of the TWG.

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Technical Working Group on the Quezon City C40 Cities Finance Facility shall have the following functions, duties and responsibilities:

3.1. Oversee the implementation and establish clear deadlines that is according to the project schedule and work plan;

3.2. To create guidelines/criteria as basis for the assessment and identification of pilot schools for the project;

3.3. To coordinate with national government agencies and with all other stakeholders in the implementation of the project;

3.4. To conduct legal and institutional study to develop tender documents, financing strategies and contract models for Public-Private Partnership (PPP) investments;

3.5 To monitor project delivery and progress;

3.6 To evaluate the project's performance and impact to the stakeholders.

SECTION 3. DISSEMINATION. A copy of this Executive Order shall be furnished to the Office of the President and the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) for information and guidance, pursuant to Section 455(1)(xii) of RA 7160, as amended, and shall be posted at the official website of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances, orders, guidelines, rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
