



# DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDS AND RECOMMENDING APPROVAL FOR CONTRACT AWARDS

- WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the Bids and Awards Committee for Infrastructure (QC-BAC-Infra) downloaded an Invitation to Bid (ITB) dated. November 14, 2022 in the Phil-GEPS and at conspicuous places in Quezon City Hall for the public bidding to be held on December 06, 2022, for twenty four (24) infrastructure projects of the City Government;
- WHEREAS, a total of fifty four (54) Document Request List (DRL) to participate were received from prospective contractors and were issued bid documents;
- WHEREAS, during the scheduled public bidding held on December 06, 2022, fifty one (51) bid proposals were received and opened and, after examination of said documents, thirty six (36) were declared passed and their corresponding bid price read while fifteen (15) were declared failed and three (3) for non-submission of bidding documents;
- WHEREAS, threee (3) motion/request for reconsideration were received by the QC-BAC-Infra from bidders whose bid were declared failed;
- WHEREAS, by virtue of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, the BAC determines that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid/Highest Rated Bid fails the criteria for post-qualification, it shall immediately notify the said bidder in writing of its post-disqualification and the grounds for it;
- WHEREAS, evaluation of all bids received and rated passed and post-qualification of bidders with the lowest calculated bid submitted for each specific project have been conducted as prescribed in the Revised IRR of RA 9184;

JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, in her capacity as City Mayor, herein after referred to as the QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT;

E. I. VILLACORTE CONSTRUCTION a domestic company duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal Office at 53 Cluster 3 Manunggal Street, Tatalon, Quezon City and herein represented by MR. EDUARDO I. VILLACORTE in his capacity as GENERAL MANAGER hereinafter referred to as the CONTRACTOR;

WHEREAS, the QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT is desirous that the Contractor execute for the *PROPOSED REHABILITATION OF SINAGTALA DAY CARE AND LIVELIHOOD FACILITY, BARANGAY SAN ANTONIO & PROJECT NO. 22-00140* and the City has accepted the Bid for *ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND FORTY FOUR PESOS & 40/100 CTVS. 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- (j) Performance Security;
- (k) Notice of Award of Contract and the Bidder's conforme thereto;
- (I) Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Entity.
- 3. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Contractor as hereinafter mentioned, the Contractor hereby covenants with the Entity to execute and complete the Works and remedy any defects therein in conformity with the provisions of this Contract in all respects.
