



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 51
Series of 2022

RECONSTITUTING THE QUEZON CITY TASK FORCE DISIPLINA, PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION, DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Sections 4 and 5, Article II of the 1987 Constitution establishes that the prime duty of the Government is to serve and protect the people, and that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act (RA) No 7160, otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*, mandates every Local Government Unit (LGU) to exercise powers essential to the promotion of the general welfare, and within their territorial jurisdiction ensure safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of the inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 48. S. 2019, created the Quezon City Task Force Disiplina.

WHEREAS, the role of the Task Force Disiplina continues, hence the need for its reconstitution.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, Mayor of Quezon City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. RECONSTITUTION. The Quezon City Task Force Disiplina is hereby reconstituted.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The Task Force Disiplina shall continue to exist under the Office of the City Mayor, and shall be composed of the following:

- 2.1 Chairperson : The City Mayor
- 2.2 Vice Chairperson: The Assistant City Administrator for Operations
- 2.3 Action Officer : The Special Adviser to the Mayor
- 2.4 Members : The Head, Department of Public Order and Safety
The Head, Transport and Traffic Management
Department
The District Director, Quezon City Police District

The Head, Department of Sanitation and Cleanup
Works of Quezon City
The Head, Climate Change and Environmental
Sustainability Department
The Head, Market Development and Administration
Department
The Head, City Veterinary Department
The Head, City Health Department
The Head, Social Services Development Department
The Head, Barangay and Community Relations
Department
The Head, Business Permits and Licensing
Department
The City Legal Officer
The Head, Department of Building Official
The Head, Department of Engineering
The President, Liga ng mga Barangay-QC Chapter

The Chairperson may designate additional members as needed.

SECTION 3. FUNCTIONS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Task Force Disiplina shall continue to have the following functions, duties and responsibilities:

- 3.1 Enforce all relevant Quezon City ordinances, rules and regulations, as determined by the Task Force;
- 3.2 Enforce all ordinances, rules and regulations pertinent to the City's main thoroughfares;
- 3.3 Monitor and evaluate the Task Force's operations for further improvement;
- 3.4 Coordinate with agencies of the National Government, with all of the Barangays in Quezon City, and with all Departments and Offices involved in the work of the Task Force towards the implementation of the Task Force's enforcement objectives;
- 3.5 Regularly meet and conduct special meetings as necessary;
- 3.6 Perform all other functions assigned by the Chairperson or Vice Chairperson.

SECTION 4. ACTION TEAM. To carry out this order, the Action Team to be headed by an Action Officer shall continue to function attached to the Task Force. This Action Team shall continue to be under the direct supervision of the City Mayor as the Chairperson of the Task Force, functioning as the implementing arm of the Task Force.


SECTION 5. RESOURCE AVAILABILITY. Funds necessary to carry out the functions of Task Force Disiplina shall be sourced from the available funds of the Office of the City Mayor.

SECTION 6. DISSEMINATION. A copy of this Executive Order shall be furnished to the Office of the President and the Metro Manila Development Authority

for information and guidance, pursuant to Section 455 (1) (xii) of RA 7160, as amended,
and shall be posted at the official website of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take immediately.
