**AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE CITY PROJECT MONITORING COMMITTEE
(PMC) OF THE CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE PHILIPPINES**

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 376, Series of 1989, as amended by the Executive Order No. 93, Series of 1993, provides for the establishment of the Regional Project Monitoring and Evaluation System (RPMES) as an institutional mechanism for monitoring and evaluating projects at the national, regional and city/municipal levels;

WHEREAS, multi-level project monitoring instituted through the RPMES provides a valuable source of inputs in budgeting and programming decisions that can maximize utilization of meager resources and protect national and local investments for local development while facilitating greater participation of government agencies, local government units (LGUs) and non-government organizations (NGO);

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2004-78, Series of 2004, was issued to facilitate organization and reconstitution of PMCs nationwide and to further strengthen the roles of said committee in ensuring transparency and accountability in the implementation of local development programs and projects;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-188 dated November 4, 2019 entitled Organization or Reconstitution of Sub Regional PMCs, was issued to facilitate organization and reconstitution of PMCs nationwide and to further strengthen the roles of said committee in ensuring transparency and accountability in the implementation of local development programs and projects;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 48 S-2022 constituted by the City Development Council with a main function of formulating a long term, medium term and annual socio-economic development programs and projects;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, City Mayor of Quezon City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law; do hereby order the reconstitution of the City Development Council Project Monitoring Committee.

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE PMC AND SECRETARIAT

Based on DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-188, the City Development Council Project Monitoring Committee shall perform the following duties and functions:

- a) Provide a list of all projects to be monitored to the NGOs involved in project monitoring;
- b) Collect and process reports of implementers and NGO monitors on the status of project implementation for the information of the LDC and the next higher level PMC;
- c) Determine problem related to the implementation of programs and projects and verify information to be submitted for analysis and action of the LDC; provide feedback on the remedial actions of the City Development Council and follow up implementation;
- d) Prepare and disseminate periodic project monitoring report on the status of project implementation to the Chairman of the CDC
- e) Elevate to higher lever bodies issues and problems which are not resolved at the local PMC level.

The City Project Monitoring Committee Secretariat shall perform the following;

- a) Prepare the Monitoring and Evaluation work program to be undertaken by the City Development Council Project Monitoring Committee during any fiscal year which will include the list of projects and schedule of implementation based on the submitted and approved City Development Plan;
- b) Provide the City Mayor with information on the projects to be monitored by the PMC; and
- c) Facilitate inter-agency, inter-governmental and department coordination, if necessary.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
