RESOLUTION NO. B001; S - 2023

DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDS AND RECOMMENDING APPROVAL FOR CONTRACT AWARDS

- WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the Bids and Awards Committee for Infrastructure (QC-BAC-Infra) downloaded an Invitation to Bid (ITB) dated March 29, 2023 in the Phil-GEPS and at conspicuous places in Quezon City Hall for the public bidding to be held on April 26, 2023, for twenty four (24) infrastructure projects of the City Government;
- WHEREAS, a total of forty two (42) Document Request List (DRL) to participate were received from prospective contractors and were issued bid documents;
- WHEREAS, the QC-Bac Infra & Consultancy issued Bid Bulletin No. 001-2023, re-scheduling the time of opening of bids from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM of the same day, work description and scope of work for the proposed Construction of Multi-Level Multi Purpose Building (Baskeball Court and Offices) at Barangay Lourdes (Project No. 23-00014);;
- WHEREAS, during the scheduled public bidding held on April 26, 2023, forty two (42) bid proposals were received and opened and, after examination of said documents, twenty eight (28) were declared passed and their corresponding bid price read while fourteen (14) were declared failed;
- WHEREAS, no motion/request for reconsideration was received by the QC-BAC-Infra from bidders whose bid were declared failed;
- WHEREAS, by virtue of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, the BAC determines that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid/Highest Rated Bid fails the criteria for post-qualification, it shall immediately notify the said bidder in writing of its post-disqualification and the grounds for it;
- WHEREAS, evaluation of all bids received and rated passed and post-qualification of bidders with the lowest calculated bid submitted for each specific project have been conducted as prescribed in the Revised IRR of RA 9184;
- NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED by the QC-BAC-Infra & Consultancy to declare the following bidders as having the lowest calculated and responsive bids submitted for the corresponding projects bid out by the QC-BAC-Infra & Consultancy on April 26, 2023:
