JOINT DTI-DA ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. <u>02</u> Series of 2008

SUBJECT

Implementing Rules and Regulations on the Grant of Special Discounts to Persons with Disability on the Purchase of Basic Necessities and Prime Commodities pursuant to Section 32 (j) of R.A. No. 9442, otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Disabled Persons and for Other Purposes.

WHEREAS. Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9442 also known as the Magna Carta for Disabled Persons and for Other Purposes was signed into law on 30 April 2007 by President Glorie Macapagal-Arroyo amending R.A. No. 7277 and granting other privileges and incentives to persons with disability:

WHEREAS, Section 32 (4) of R.A. No. 9442 provides that "to the extent possible, the government may grant special discounts in special programs for persons with disability on purchase of basic commodities, subject to the guidelines to be issued for the purpose by the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) and the Department of Agriculture (DA).

NOW THEREFORE, WE PETER B. FAVILA, Secretary of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) and ARTHUR C. YAP, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture (DA), in accordance with Section 32 (J) of RA, 9442 and Section 5, 9 of its implementing rules and regulations (IRIQ), cherwise known as Magna Catta for Ibasided Persons and for Other Purposes, do hereby issue the Order providing special discounts to person with disability on the purchase of basic necessities and right commodities under DTI and DA, Intradictions:

Section 1. Scope and Coverage – this Order shall apply to persons with disability who are Filipino citizens, and retailers as defined under Section 2 (c) hereof.

Section 2. Definition of Terms - For purposes of this Order, these terms as defined are as follows:

- (a.) "Basic Necessities" refers to rice, corn, bread, fresh, dried and canned fish and other marine products, fresh port, beef and poultry meat, fresh eggs, fresh and processed milk, Infant formulas, fresh vegetables, ro
- (b.) "Prime Commodities" refers to fresh fruits, flour, dried, processed and canned pork, beef and poultry, meat, dairy products not failing under basic necessies. noodles, ontons, garlic, dispers, herbickies, poultry, swine and cattles fleeds, seletimary products for poultry, swine and cattle, paper, school supplee, in pash shipple, plyband, construction nails, listenies, electrical supples, light bubs, sele wire and other commodities that may be classified by the Department of Tade and Industry (101) and the Department of Agriculture (101).
- (c.) "Retailer" shall mean any natural or juridical person engaged in the business of selling consumer products directly to consumers, which shall include among others, supermarkets, grocery stores, convenience and miniconvenience stores and stopes, excluding sari-and stores with a capitalization of less than One Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 100,000.00), public and private wet markets, - "talipapa" and cooperative stores,
- (d.) "Persons with Disability" shall refer to any person suffering from restriction or different abilities, as a result of mental, physical and sensory impairment to perform an activity in a manner or within the range considered normal for human being. Disability shall immen (1) a physical or mental impairment that sustainability limits one or psychological, or anatomical function of an individual or activities of such individuals; (2) a record of such impairment; or (1) been regarded as having such impairment.

Section 6. Special Lane – retailers shall provide a special express lane for persons with disability, in the absence heavy, priority shall be given to them.

Section 7. Prohibition on Availment on Double Discounts – The privilege herein granted shall not be claimed if the person with disability claims a higher discount as may be granted by the retail establishment and/or other existing laws or in combination with other discount program such as those extended to sentince rollzens.

Section 8. Authorize Representatives – A person with disability who cannot personally purchase basic necessities and prime commodities under Section 2 (a) and (b) of this Order may, by written authority, appoint a representative to transact with a retailer on hisher behalf. The authorited representative shall be required to present a valid government issued identification document together with the LGU – Issued identification issued document of the concerned person with disability and an authorization letter.

However, for those who cannot possibly purchase basic commodities under Section 2 (a) and (b) of this Order beautiful properties of his/her disability, a permanent representative within he immediate family or the legal guardina, as the case may be shall automatically be considered even without the afloresaid written authorization; Provised that the name of the authorized person's shall be indicated in the purchase booklet or in the identification card that will be issued to the person with disability.

Section 9. Penal and Administrative Sanctions - Penal and administrative sanctions are those which are provided or R.A. No. 9442

Section 10. Effectivity – This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a national newspaper
