WHEREAS, Section 17, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall give priority to education, science, and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development;

WHEREAS, in support of this mandate, the Department of Education issued DepEd Order No. 57, s.2011 entitled "Policy Guidelines in the Implementation of the Special Science Elementary School (SSES) Projects";

WHEREAS, the Department of Education through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) launched and implemented the Special Science Elementary Schools (SSES) Project in 2007 to 57 Public Elementary Schools;

WHEREAS, Enclosure No. 2 of DepEd Order No. 57, s.2011, identified Project 6 Elementary School as part of Batch 1 of the Special Science Elementary School (SSES) Project;

WHEREAS, the objective of establishing Special Science Elementary Schools is to develop Filipino children who are equipped with scientific and technological knowledge, skills and attitudes, who are creative and have positive values and lifelong learning skills to become productive partners in the development of the community and society;

WHEREAS, the School Governing Council of Project 6 Elementary School through SGC Resolution No. 02, s.2022 and Barangay Project 6 Resolution No. 40, s.2022, favorably endorsed to the Local School Board the renaming of Project 6 Elementary School to Project 6 Special Science Elementary School;

WHEREAS, the members of the Local School Board through Resolution No. 4, s.2024, approved the converting of Project 6 Elementary School to Project 6 Special Science Elementary School.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Project 6 Elementary School, located at Road 7, Barangay Project 6, District I, Quezon City, is hereby converted under the Quezon City Schools Division Office as Project 6 Special Science Elementary School.

SECTION 2. The supplemental funds necessary for the maintenance and operation of the said Special Science School, as determined by the Local School Board, may be taken from the Special Education Funds of Quezon City or from any available funds of the City.

SECTION 3. In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


