AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. NC-153, S-90.

WHEREAS, there is a proliferation on unregulated display of advertising articles or objects including political propaganda such as but not limited to streamers, tarpaulins, tin plates, stickers, pamphlets, decals, printed notices, signboards, billboards and other advertising paraphernalia;

WHEREAS, most of such advertising articles or objects and political propaganda may constitute as hazards to pedestrians and most motorists and can cause accidents;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council passed different Ordinances pertaining to rules and regulations in installing streamers, stickers, decals, pamphlets, tin plates, cardboards, billboards, or other advertisement paraphernalia;

WHEREAS, political propaganda must only be posted/displayed in a common posting area designated by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC);


WHEREAS, it is paramount to include the political propaganda in prohibition of posting and display of streamers, sticker, decals, pamphlet, tin plates, cardboards, billboards, or other advertisement paraphernalia.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. NC-153, S-90 is hereby amended and read as follow:

"SECTION 1. An Ordinance prohibiting any person to display, or attach any streamers, stickers, decals, pamphlets, tin plates, cardboards, or other advertisement paraphernalia which will give notice, advertisement and/or endorsement for any film showing, business or professional services, or similar activities or undertaking and political propaganda or any display of political or partisan activity in giving of an announcement and greeting of an activity to any Meralco Post and/or Traffic Light/signal Post, portion of Bridges and overpass and providing penalties for violation thereof."
